

GFWC Florida Website Contest

All entries must be emailed to webcontest@gfwcflorida.org with “Website contest” in the subject. Please include your name, club name, district, and URL and any other notes you may want to send. You may continue to update your site after you submit, however, the webmaster will not be able to help with questions except in special cases (can’t get domain to work or some problem with website.)

The deadline is February 1. Please do not submit prior to December 1.

Club websites or blogs must have these items and should have all plus any others pertaining to your club:

- GFWC in the URL
- official name on site
- specific club email (such as happyclub@hotmail.com, happyclub@yourdomain.org, etc)
- contact info for club (address, phone)
- meeting location or how to find out
- meeting times
- links to GFWC and GFWC Florida on homepage
- links to sites of interest
- description of club activities and or departments/committees

The email for entry must say (clubname) webcontest and send to webcontest@gfwcflorida.org

The email **must have in the body** (NO attachments):

- Club name
- District
- Website address
- Number of members
- President of club, email
- Webmaster for club, email
- **NO more than 250-word** essay describing website’s purpose and the club’s approach for website maintenance

These requirements must be met in order to enter the contest. Failure to do so disqualifies the entry.

Please note, it is YOUR responsibility to see that your club is listed on the GFWC Florida and the GFWC websites. We send our winning state entry to GFWC so GFWC rules are incorporated into our rules. If ANY are not followed, you will be disqualified. It your responsibility to verify you have met standards for GFWC Florida prior to submitting your entry.
